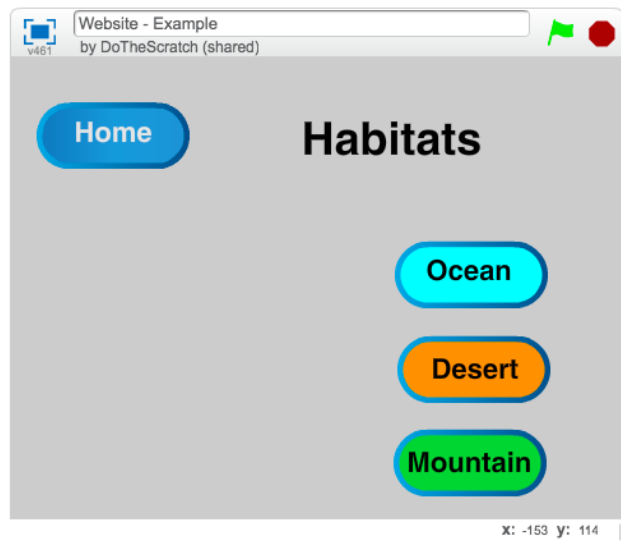


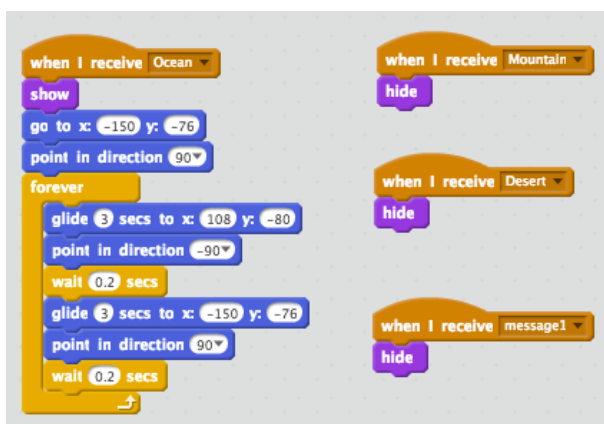
## Workshop

**Length:** 2 - 3 Hours

**Subjects:** Computer Science, ELA, Social Studies, Science



## Topics

- Computer Science: Basics of Web Design
- ELA: Character traits, conflict, and resolution; Storyboard the plot of a story.
- Social Studies: Create a website for Native American Tribes highlighting their unique shelters.

## Outline

1. **Introduction to Scratch** - Investigate Sprites, Scripts, Costumes and Backgrounds.
2. **Home Page** - Design a homepage based on a content-area topic.
3. **Subpages** - Design Subpages based on your topic.
4. **How Pages Interact** - Use coding blocks like "Broadcast" to control when pages, buttons and backgrounds are visible.
5. **Extension** - Add sprites and movement blocks to your pages. Investigate possible extensions for your classroom.
6. **Share out** - Explain the inspiration for your website.
7. **Connect** - Make connections to other content areas and existing lesson plans.
